WHAT TO EXPECT

During treatment, ultra-fine needles are inserted into specific facial and body acupuncture points. Many patients find the experience deeply relaxing. Depending on your provider, additional supportive tools may be used – such as facial cupping, gua sha, LED light therapy, or the **Rejuveness Sytem** (a gentle electromagnetic wave device).

TREATMENT COURSE & ANTECIPATED EFFECTS

- Initial results may include a brighter, more rested appearance
- Most treatment plans involve 10-12 sessions, ideally performance 1-2x per week
- Results are cumulative, with progressive lifting, toning, and smoothing
- Monthly maintenance is recommended following your initial course
- Improvements may also be noticed in sleep, digestion, and mood as a result of full-body rebalancing
