



Urticaria & Allergy - IV Push

What is Urticaria & Allergy IV Push?

This IV is indicated in both prevention and treatment of hives, pruritis, conjunctivitis, sneezing, and runny nose associated with environmental and food allergies. It aims to modulate the immune response to triggering allergens and mitigate the histamine reaction leading to allergy symptoms.

Vitamin C, or ascorbic acid is a potent antioxidant that protects cells from damage and reduces the severity of allergic reactions. It slows the over reaction of the body to environmental allergens by decreasing histamine production.

Taurine alleviates allergic inflammation by reducing eosinophilic and mast cell infiltration into the nasal cavity and in the skin. It also supports the liver in detoxification of pollutants. B5 works similarly to relieve nasal congestion.

A proprietary blend of amino acids provides adequate nutrients for further support immune reactions.

Homeopathics specific for allergies and urticaria are also included in this IV formulation.

Uses

- Hives (urticaria)
- Allergic rhinitis and conjunctivitis
- Seasonal and food allergies, hay fever

Side Effects

Common

- Fatigue
- Bruising or redness at IV access site

Rare

- Allergic reaction
- Nausea
- Syncope

Ingredients

- L-Taurine
- Ascorbic Acid
- B5
- Aminosyn II 8.5%
- Pascoe Agil
- Pascallerg
- Quassia
- 0.9% Normal Saline

Procedure

A single bag is administered from a single IV access site.

Duration

30 - 45 minutes

Patient Prep

Please arrive on time and be well-hydrated. Please ensure that you have eaten prior to the intravenous treatment.

Please inform a lab technician and/or your doctor if you have any allergies; have a history of any reaction to intravenous treatment or have any concerns regarding this treatment.
